

Staircase to HEAVEN

This is a self-supporting straight run staircase, designed for a holiday house in the isle of Favignana. According to the local laws this had to be a standalone and removable structure. The aluminium framework, handrail and the teak steps were all fixed with steel screws. The landing supports are directly welded to the steel bars of the main wall and are the only fixed part of the entire staircase.
